Management met with **TCAP** executives to discuss Garland's new ordinance that requires the sterilization of all dogs and cats over the age of 6 months. As a way to celebrate our partnership and their commitment to the Garland community, TCAP will send a \$20 spay/neuter voucher to every registered pet owner in the City of Garland. The voucher is good for up to 4 pets per household. This voucher is valid with the purchase of a set of vaccines for \$25 or the purchase of a microchip for \$20.



A citizen emailed us these pictures of what seems to be a wolf-hybrid. When we responded to the address in question, no dogs or wolves were found on the premises. Wolves or wolf-hybrids are prohibited in the City of Garland.
