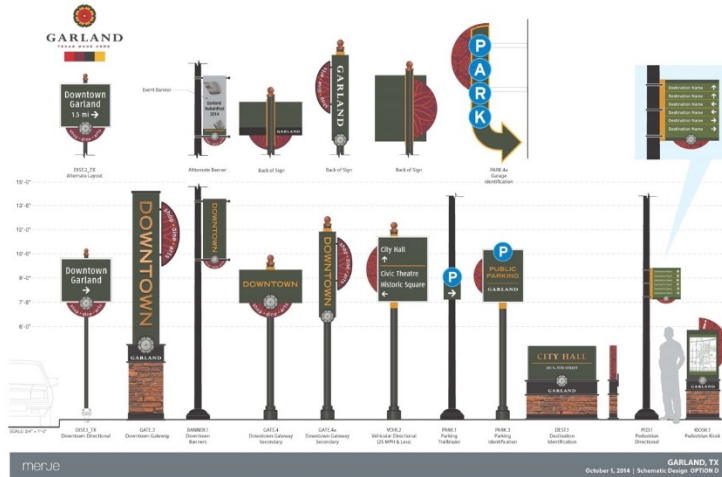

- The Downtown Streetscape Program provides funding for the design and construction of streetscape improvements in Downtown at key entry points and areas near redevelopment activity.
- Funding requested for 2018 will provide improvements to Austin Street, between Sixth Street and Glenbrook Avenue.

- This project will continue funding the remaining elements of the Wayfinding Enhancement program.
- The funding requested for 2018 will allow for fabrication and installation.

- Gateways aid in wayfinding and orientation for both residents and visitors and clue them that they are entering or leaving a special area.
- Funding requested for 2018 will provide signage and landscaping at Main Street and Fifth Street; Fifth Street and Avenue D; and Garland Avenue and Main Street.
